MLK DAY of Service

In our latest community endeavor, we are thrilled to share the remarkable success of the MLK Day Winter Care Kit Packing event that unfolded at Life on Lexington Church. This collaborative effort, orchestrated in partnership with High Point LEAP and the African American Initiative (AAI) of the United Way of Greater High Point, brought together volunteers from AAI, Bank of America, High Point University, and Triad Business Bank along with several other individuals. With their dedicated support, we assembled close to an impressive 700 Winter Care Kits for the homeless population in Greater High Point.









The event, held on Monday, January 15th, from 10 AM to 12 PM, saw the convergence of community partners and volunteers. Packed with essential items like rain ponchos, cough drops, lotion, gloves, socks, lip balm, nail clippers, travel wipes, tissues, band-Aids, and individually wrapped granola bars, these care kits were distributed to those experiencing homelessness in Guilford County as part of the Point in Time Count (in collaboration with City of Greensboro Housing & Neighborhood Development Department, Guilford County Animal Services, and Partners Ending Homelessness).

This initiative not only exemplified the commitment of the AAI and High Point LEAP but also paid homage to Martin Luther King Jr.'s legacy of service. Thank you for your generosity and commitment!
